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Dive into a world of snow and ice!  
 In theory and practice participants discover something worth knowing about the nightmare scenario of an avalanche. How does an avalanche occur? How does a device to detect people buried in an avalanche work? Questions are taken up, discussed and tested. When devising an individual programme, we are happy to include a visit to the Swiss Institute for Snow and Avalanche Research in Davos.

**Valid:** December–April  
**Special features:** Organisation of a tour to the Swiss Institute for Snow and Avalanche Research in Davos – combine the training course with a snowshoe trip to the High Alps or build an igloo.

Instead of contemplating them, forests should be experienced in person. Participants learn about the mountain forests as well as its opportunities and problems at first hand through practical forestry work. The work is performed under expert supervision. In this way companies and groups make an active contribution to looking after protected forests. The two projects “Silviva Waldpause” and “Bergwaldprojekt” actively promote the care and maintenance of the forests and woods of Graubünden. The programmes can be adjusted to your wishes.

## Bergwaldprojekt.

**Valid:** April to October

**Special features:** Accommodation, meals and project management are taken over by the Stiftung “Bergwaldprojekt” (Mountain Forest Project Trust). Depending on the location you will spend the night in a trekking tent. Led by experienced project and group leaders.

**Duration:** Taster days: 1 day; Project week: Sunday to Saturday. For companies, 3-day deployments are also offered.

Numerous animals and plants live in traditional landscapes on land cultivated and developed by man. Managing these landscapes is very labour-intensive and almost impossible to cope with for mountain agriculture. If these areas are given up, they revert back to nature within a few years and there is soon a forest.

The WWF is involved in maintaining and linking up the ecological valuable dry locations in the Lower Engadine and is lending a hand itself. Volunteers pull up bushes on overgrown areas, trim hedges and look after habitats, pile up residual rocks or repair dry stone walls. Flowers, insects, reptiles and small animals quickly re-settle there.

**Valid:** Mid-May to mid-October

**Special features:** Overnight accommodation if requested in groups; youth hostels or hotel/guest house; expert advice in our mountain forest training workshop; introduction to the subject; heavy work such as felling trees is undertaken by experts; lighter work using a hand saw, tree pruning, collecting wood is carried out by volunteers. Full board possible. We are happy to meet your special wishes for excursions in the region on a special topic.

**Duration:** Deployment in the field lasts at least one day without travel time. Several days’ deployment is most welcome.

**Group size:** 8 to 25 people
